



**BASIC SCHOOL SUPPLIES LIST FOR 2009-2010**  
HAZELWOOD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

**Families are expected to provide the following basic school supplies.** Please avoid buying toys disguised as school supplies (very distracting) and items not listed below. Organized, tidy desks are a key to success in all grades. Thanks!

**FIRST GRADE**

**\*These supplies will be shared by the class; please do not label.**

- \*1-2 family size boxes of tissue
- \*20 small glue sticks
- \*3-4 erasers, pink pearl
- Pencils - 2 dozen **sharpened**  
TICONDEROGA preferred
- \*Crayola markers - thin & thick
- \*Thin yellow highlighters
- \*Healthy snack (example graham crackers or goldfish)
- \*Ream of copy paper
- Backpack: standard size
- Crayons (Crayola - prefer 24)
- 2 folders with bottom pockets labeled with child's name
- School box (no larger than 5"x9")
- Scissors, Fiskar-type preferred
- 2 inch 3 ring binder labeled with student's name
- Hand sanitizer

Optional items

- \*Ziploc bags: snack, sandwich, quart & gallon
- \*Colored pencils
- \*AA & AAA batteries
- \*Disinfecting wipes
- \*Mr. Clean Magic Erasers

**SECOND GRADE**

**\*These supplies will be shared by the class; please do not label.**

- Backpack, small
- \*2 boxes of tissue (Kleenex)
- Crayons, box of 24
- \*6-12 glue sticks
- \*6 erasers (pink pearl)
- 2 folders with bottom pockets
- \*3 dozen #2 pencils, **sharpened**  
TICONDEROGA preferred
- Markers (Crayola preferred)
- School box (small)
- Scissors - Fiskar type preferred
- 1 spiral notebook, wide ruled
- 2 reams of white copy paper
- Chlorox wipes
- Hand sanitizer, not pump top
- Yellow highlighters

Optional items

- Ziploc bags: snack, sandwich, quart or gallon size
- Graham crackers/Goldfish
- Paper bags – white
- Mr. Clean Magic Erasers
- AA & AAA batteries
- Band-aids
- Napkins/cups

**THIRD GRADE**

- 1-2 family size boxes of tissue
- Pencils – 1 dozen, **sharpened**  
(No mechanical)
- 2-3 erasers, pink pearl (not pencil top or decorative that smear)
- Paper, wide rule (not in tablet or spiral notebook form)
- Glue sticks
- Backpack, standard (labeled)
- Crayons, box of 24 (labeled)
- Markers, washable broad line assorted colors, box of 8 (labeled)
- Scissors, Fiskar-type preferred (labeled)
- 1 One and a half inch 3 ring binder (no Trapper Keepers, zippers or lace)
- 1 small package of subject dividers
- 1 red pocket folder & 1 blue pocket folder
- 12" wooden ruler with metric on the opposite side
- Small, but sturdy, pencil sharpener to be kept in desk
- 1 four oz. bottle of glue, such as Elmers Glue
- 1 ream of white printer paper (to be shared with the class)

**FOURTH GRADE**

- Backpack, standard
- Box of tissue, Kleenex
- Crayons
- Glue stick
- Elmer's glue
- Eraser, pink pearl
- Markers, water-soluble
- Notebook paper, wide ruled

**(sharpened)**

- Ruler (metric & inch)
- Scissors, Fiskar-type preferred
- 2 Composition notebooks (college ruled)
- Subject dividers, 8 to 10 dividers
- Three-ring binder
- Small pencil sharpener for desk
- Red correcting pens
- Inexpensive calculator
- Yellow highlighter
- Thesaurus - paperback
- Scotch tape (to be shared with class)
- Ream of white printer paper (to be shared with class)

**FIFTH GRADE**

- Backpack, standard
- 3-ring binder
- 1 binder three hole punch
- 3 spiral notebooks
- Subject dividers (package of 6 or more)
- 1 inexpensive calculator
- Notebook paper
- Pencil pouch
- 1 small covered pencil sharpener
- Pencils, #2 lead, 1 dozen (at least)
- Eraser, pink pearl
- 1 box of 12 Crayola watercolor pencils
- Marking pens or fine tip colored markers for art projects
- Blue or black erasable ballpoint pen
- Ruler (both metric & standard)
- Scissors, Fiskar-type preferred (sharp)
- 4 glue sticks or Elmer's glue (to be shared with the class)
- Box of tissues, Kleenex
- 1 box of Ziploc bags, gallon size
- Red correcting pen
